### **DESCRIPTION OF CONFERENCE & WARNING OF RISK**

Participants of this Conference have the option to engage in many activities such as indoor rock climbing, fly casting, bike maintenance, outdoor cooking, fire building, ski tuning, snowshoeing, orienteering, and more. There will be over 50 workshop offerings designed to engage Conference attendees in the outdoors. We have posted the most up-to-date listing of these workshops on our website along with a brief description and information on workshop leaders. These activities will primarily take place indoors at Windham High School, but some sessions might take advantage of nice weather to do some activities outside the school on school grounds. Although serious injuries are not common during supervised activities, it is impossible to eliminate the risk. Participants must obey all safety rules, report all physical problems, and follow the directions given by workshop presenters. Participants under 18 years of age must have the permission of their parent/guardian both to register and participate.

### **AGREEMENT TO PUBLISH STUDENT INFORMATION**

We will be taking photos during the Conference for use in Teens To Trails promotional materials & website. We will never use names with photos without obtaining your written consent as parent/guardian. Any pictures on the website, in our exhibits, in a newsletter or brochure will not associate names with faces.

### **CONFERENCE PARTICIPANT RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT**

I understand that participation in the T3 "Life Happens Outside!" Conference 2010 involves inherent risks and dangers. I further understand that I will be participating with others under circumstances where accidents, mistakes or other circumstances may result in injury to me or my child. To enable Teens To Trails to offer such programs:

1. On behalf of myself and/or my child, I accept and assume the risk of bodily injury, death or property damage occurring while participating in the above activities from these and other risks and dangers. I and/or my child voluntarily choose to participate in the activities notwithstanding such risks and dangers, I understand that I or my child can cease participation at any time, and I and my child accept full and sole responsibility for doing so.
2. I am aware of the level of fitness needed for these activities. I certify that I or my child have no medical condition or restriction that prevents me or my child from safely participating in this Conference.

I, for myself, my child, and our heirs, successors, assigns and personal representatives, hereby release and discharge Teens To Trails, their respective agents, officers, directors, event sponsors, all volunteers & their respective organizations, and successors and assigns (hereinafter referred to individually or collectively as "Releasees") from any liability or causes of action whatever arising from, or on account of, property damage, economic loss, personal injury or death, related to my participation or my child's participation in the activities, including, without limitation, any liability or causes of action based on, asserting, or caused by, the negligence of Releasees or of other persons, for breach of contract or liability asserted on any other ground.
