This FREE training program offered through

Washington County Community College
equips participants with the knowledge, skill and
certifications needed to meet the Educational
Trip Leader Permit (ETL) requirements
recently enacted by the Maine State Legislature.

In addition to the ETL permit, participants will have the opportunity receive the following additional credentials:

- Leave No Trace Awareness Certificate
- Wilderness First Aid certification

When is an ETL Permit Required?

An ELT permit is required when an educational institution conducts outdoor educational trips that would normally require a Registered Maine Guide -overnight trips away from potable water and/or trips that occur on Maine's waterways.

Who can hold an ETL Permit?

In accordance with Maine State Law, A person applying for the ETL permit must:

- be at least 18 years old;
- be affiliated with a primary, secondary, or post-secondary school;
- have successfully completed the ETL training and testing; and,
- hold a valid and updated Wilderness First Aid (or greater) and CPR certification

Program Information

Course: Educational Trip Leader

This Hybrid course provides students with an introduction to the field of outdoor education including the knowledge and skills required to obtain the Maine Educational Trip Leader permit. This is a sixteen hour course with eight hours of online training combined with eight hours of in-person training.
